

## High Sierra Camp Comparison Chart

Camp Location	Elevation	Toilet	Shower & Laundry	Electricity	Parking
Glen Aulin	7,800 ft	Flush	No	No	Park around Lembert Dome/Tuolumne Stables and walk in on the trail (about 5 miles slightly downhill) along Tuolumne River
May Lake	9,270 ft	Flush	Yes	No	There is a dirt road from Hwy 120 leading up to a paved parking area. From there it is uphill 1.2 miles by trail to the camp.
Sunrise	9,400 ft	Compost	Yes	No	Park at the Sunrise Lakes trailhead at the west end of Tenaya Lake. The trail is approximately 5 miles to Sunrise High Sierra Camp and has some strenuous switchbacks in the first 2.5 miles.
Merced	7,150 ft	Flush	Yes	No	Long hike regardless of where you park from. Recommended to do only as part of a loop or half loop.
Vogelsang	10,100 ft	Compost	No	No	Park near the Tuolumne Lodge and take the trail toward the Twin Bridges and follow signage to Vogelsang. Approximately 7 miles uphill (mostly gradual) to get to camp.
